Hello Academic Decathlon and Octathlon Coaches,

The Keller High School Academic Decathlon Team is excited to announce our Annual Academic Decathlon Practice Meet. The tournament will include **large** and **small/medium** schools with all 10 events; the essay portion (open to all students) will be sent prior to tournament arrival. Speech and interview will be held on Friday afternoon/evening while Saturday will be dedicated to the seven objective subjects. High School will use the **USAD Round 1 Exam**. Please refrain from administering this exam to your teams prior to the meet.

ENTRY FEES

Wednesday, November 28th: Essay prompts will be emailed to registered teams. Competing teams will scan and email essays by December 3rd for scoring. We are offering quality scoring, so please be prompt with the return of the essays. **Cost is \$10 per student.**

Friday, December 7th: Schools may bring their top 12 students to compete in a mock speech and interview competition. **Cost is \$10 per student/per event.**

Saturday, December 8th: Schools may bring as many students as they would like to compete in the seven objective subject tests. **Cost is \$20 per student.**

AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for each of the 10 events, as well as the Top 3 Individuals in each category. Trophies will be awarded to the Top 3 schools. Team scores will consist of the top 2 overall scores in each category, for a total of 6 scores. Scores will include the speech, interview and essay components.

TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

Teams will need to provide their own pencils and calculators.

Teams will be on their own for lunch. The welcome packet will include a list of local restaurants. Our suggestion would be to have a coach go get food and bring it back to KHS in order to maximize time for lunch. We will send a restaurant list to registered teams.

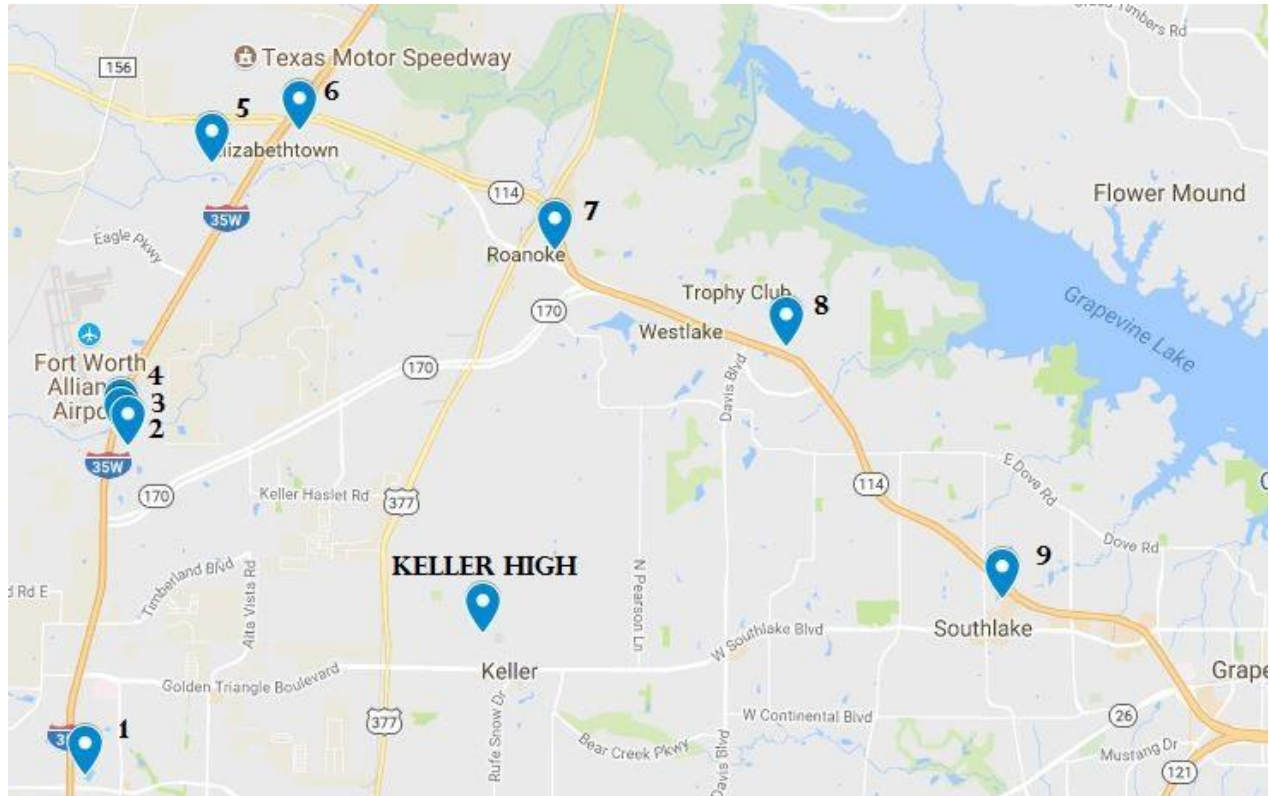

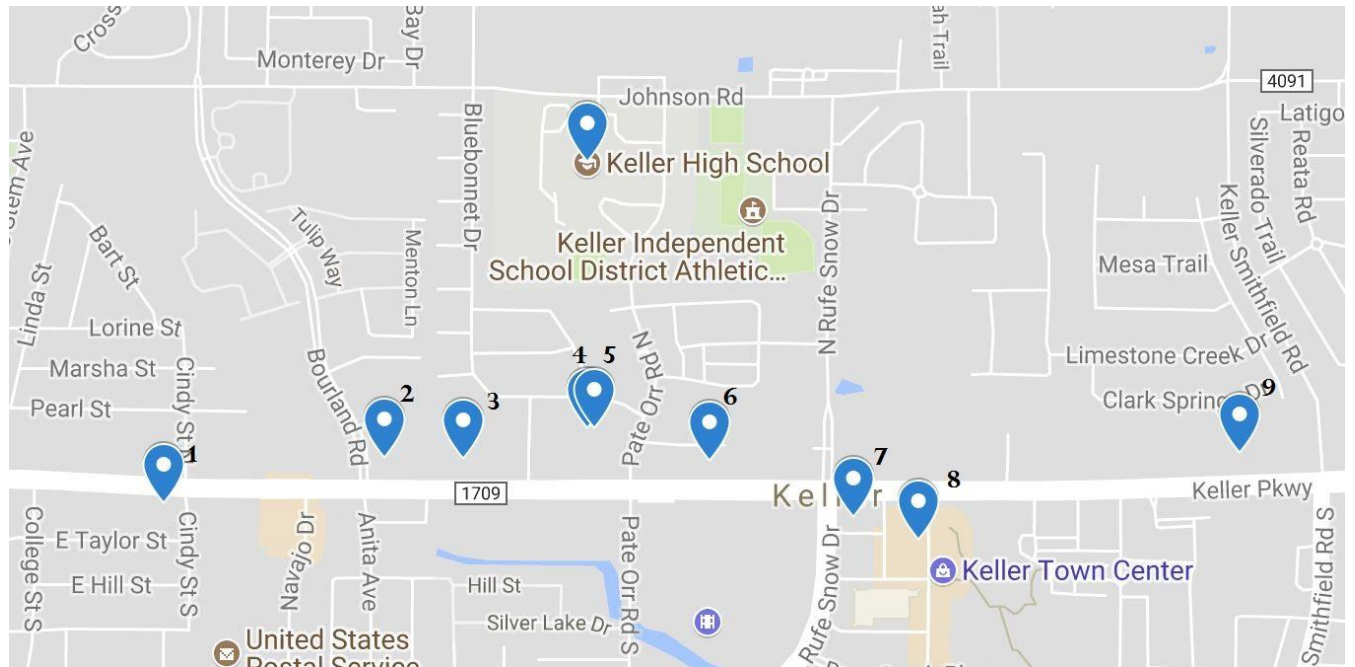
